What comes after GBC Jr.?

After *Grammar Boot Camp Jr.* lessons are completed, continue to purposefully use the GBC Jr. Notebook charts/pages as a resource during reading conversations to support deeper understanding and to study the author's sentence craft. Use grammar to support sentence construction and sentence crafting during writing.

Alice Nine's *Tactical Sentence Instruction* (TSI) routine is a practice routine that bridges grammar to writing at the sentence level as the skills of revision and editing are developed. Use the routine daily after completing GBC Jr.

When sentences are chosen/created intentionally, this routine is your mini-grammar lesson. The focus of the work in each sentence should align with appropriate standards, curriculum map, and/or instructional focus document.
